### Synod Assembly Opened on a Lively Note

The Synod Assembly of the Metropolitan Chicago Synod held at the Q Center in St. Charles on June 1 opened with a rousing song by a Dixieland band playing "When the Saints Go Marching In." The 377 registered delegates were treated to many videos showcasing various ministries in congregations throughout our synod.

The name of our deceased member Sandy Wackenhuth appeared on the screen in memory of her service to our synod when rostered leaders were remembered for their service. The delegates also had the opportunity to attend various workshops. I attended the one on Technology and Social Media, Jan Beckman attended Social Change in Congregations, and Vicki Doherty attended the workshop on Shared Space.

Resolutions brought to the floor for vote involved approving the budget for the next fiscal year, approving exploring reinvestment in areas of Chicago where racial change has occurred, and considerations for the war in the Middle East. One resolution concerning the Middle East was brought forward to submit to the Churchwide Assembly next year.

The Assembly closed with worship at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in St. Charles with the singing of contemporary hymns and presented in a bilingual format.
